The Mental Health First Aid course is appropriate for anyone who wants to learn how to help an individual – youth or adult – who may be experiencing a mental health crisis or concern, including nurses, nurse practitioners, occupational therapists, physical therapists, physicians, physician assistants, psychologists, social workers and administrators.

#### **COURSE OVERVIEW**


Mental health challenges, such as depression, anxiety, psychosis and substance use, are shockingly common in the United States. In fact, more than one in five American adults will experience a mental health problem in any given year. The need to begin a conversation about mental health challenges is necessary, and it can start with Mental Health First Aid. MHFA has been Identified on SAMHSA's National Registry of Evidence-Based Programs and Practices and is available here in Michigan. The eight-hour course gives people the skills to help someone who is developing a mental health problem or experiencing a mental health crisis. Evidence behind the program demonstrates that it does build mental health literacy, helping the public to identify, understand and respond to signs of mental illness.
