

REHABILITATION CODING AND PPS COORDINATION

Documentation drives coding, and coding drives reimbursement. Our comprehensive analysis, training and education are designed with the entire interdisciplinary team in mind. DOCUMENTATION ANALYSIS

We perform an in-depth analysis of patient documentation and identify opportunities for improvement. As part of the process, we compare documentation to codes selected for the Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility Patient Assessment Instrument (IRF-PAI) with special attention on capturing:

- Etiologic selection
- Tiering comorbidities
- 60% rule compliance
- Impairment Group Code (IGC) selection

REHABILITATION CODER TRAINING

If you recently added a coder to your team who doesn't have inpatient rehabilitation experience or if your existing coders primarily code for acute care, this program is for you. We will teach the differences between IRF-PAI coding and UB-04 coding to ensure your new team members become a cohesive part of the rehabilitation team. We have a 1:1 orientation and training program for new rehabilitation coders and a series of learning modules for those needing a refresher.

PPS COORDINATION

New PPS Coordinator Training: We provide a competency-based, orientation and training program on acceptable standards of practice.

Temporary PPS Coordinator Coverage: If you're in a pinch with limited coverage due to leaves, resignations or other unforeseen circumstances, we'll bridge your coverage gap.

PPS Education: We offer modules geared specifically to PPS coordinators and IRF-PAI completion. We'll work together to customize the program before the session to make sure your needs are met.
