Patients who have undergone amputation or were born with a limb deficiency experience a unique, lifelong journey of managing mobility, prosthetics, skin issues and adjustments to life roles. The 2021 Mary Free Bed Rehabilitation Hospital Limb Loss Conference will provide evidence-based knowledge on skin and wound care strategies and high level and bilateral gait training. Presentations will include a patient's limb loss journey, research regarding regenerative peripheral nerve interfaces, osseointegration technology, recreation therapy strategies and community resources for the patient with limb loss. The patient's journey presentation will provide a unique perspective regarding the challenges and adjustments faced after limb loss.
