

Open to any Michigan artist age 18 and older with physical disabilities.

Only works produced after physical limitation occurred will be accepted.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

Artists are encouraged to submit work(s) that fit standardsized frames (e.g., $8'' \times 10''$, $11'' \times 14''$, $16'' \times 20''$ or $24'' \times 36''$).

No entry fee is required.

Only original fine art completed **in the last two years** will be accepted.

Each artist may enter up to **three** pieces for possible inclusion in the show. The actual number displayed by an artist will depend on space availability.

Works must be framed, wired and ready for hanging when submitted. Due to the nature of the facility, the Guild reserves the right to reject unsuitable subject matter.
