
Great News

We're a state-wide resource for children's rehabilitation. From calendar years 2016 through 2022, we treated 34,564 individual inpatients and outpatients in the Mary Free Bed system and cared for 1,153 out-of-state children as well. We welcome kids with the most serious and complex conditions. During CY 2021, 57% of children in Michigan who needed inpatient rehabilitation were treated at Mary Free Bed Kids in Grand Rapids.

Even Better News

We're creating capacity to rehabilitate even more kids. In partnership with Corewell Health Helen DeVos Children's Hospital, we're constructing a free-standing hospital designed and dedicated for children's rehabilitation. We'll double the number of inpatient beds and see a 20% increase in outpatient visits. We'll serve an additional 2,000-2,500 children each year, with the total number of unique kids treated reaching between 8,500-9,000 annually.

Cascading Sustainable Results

In addition to treating more kids, the children's rehabilitation hospital will:



Decompress current overcrowded conditions.



Enable kids to transfer sooner from general acute care hospitals. Studies show when vigorous rehabilitation begins quickly, outcomes are better.



Provide more effective and efficient care as Mary Free Bed and Helen DeVos Children's specialists closely coordinate treatment.



Reduce health care costs. Early diagnosis and immediate intervention can improve life trajectories by mitigating complications and life-long health care costs.



This will be Michigan's first free-standing children's rehabilitation hospital, the ninth in the nation and one of only three located between the country's east and west coasts. A residency in pediatric rehabilitation medicine is being established, which will attract gifted clinicians. The hospital will become a medical destination for children and their families.
