OUTPATIENT PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

SPINE PHYSICAL THERAPY

(Age 13 and older)

- Back pain, including low back pain or thoracic (upper back) pain
- Facet arthritis
- Headaches
- Neck or cervical pain
- Numbness or tingling in the arms or legs
- Sciatica
- Shoulder pain, including pain that travels into the neck
- SI (Sacroiliac) joint pain
- Spondylosis or other age-related wear and tear of the spinal disks
- Stenosis
- Temporomandibular joint disorder (TMJ) or “clicking/popping” in the jaw
- Vertigo
- Weakness in the core

PAIN REHABILITATION

Ten-week program for for patients ages 15 and older that includes medical, physical therapy, occupational therapy and pain psychology:

- Chronic, non-cancer related pain
- Migraines
- Headaches
- Fibromyalgia
- Complex Regional Pain Syndrome (CRPS)
- Long-term pain associated with diabetic neuropathy
- Other conditions that result in chronic pain

POST COVID-19 REHABILITATION

For patients age 15 and older experiencing post COVID-19 symptoms, including but not limited to:

- Loss of smell or taste
- Headaches
- Memory difficulties and “brain fog”
- Chronic pain
- Deconditioning
- Dysphagia
- Fatigue
- Muscle and joint aches or pain
- Rapid heartbeat
- Respiratory problems
- Sleep issues
- Stroke related to COVID-19
- Anxiety
- Depression

NEUROLOGICAL REHABILITATION

For patients 13 and older; physical and occupational therapy available:

- Stroke/Cerebrovascular Accident (CVA)
- Mild or moderate Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI)
- Post-concussion
- Parkinson’s
- Multiple Sclerosis (MS)
- Falls
- Debility
- Adults with developmental disability
- Spinal Cord Injury (SCI)

PRE-PROCEDURE PSYCHOLOGY CONSULT

For patients age 15 and older to address fear and anxiety prior to surgery or procedure, including but not limited to:
