- 1. Graduate of an occupational therapy education program accredited by the Accreditation Council for Occupational Therapy Education (ACOTE)
- 2. A valid Michigan Occupational Therapy License by start date
- 3. CPR/AED certification
- 4. Current AOTA (American Occupational Therapy Association) member by start date

A) What are your professional goals upon completion of the neurologic fellowship program? How do you envision this fellowship program influencing your future occupational therapy practice and how do you hope to contribute to the field of neurologic occupational therapy?



- B) Why have you chosen neurologic occupational therapy and, in particular, the Mary Free Bed program? What types of experiences are you seeking in a fellowship program?
- C) Reflecting on your educational and clinical experiences, what strengths or skills do you bring to this neurologic fellowship program that will help you be successful in this specialty area? What challenges do you foresee?
- D) Share your learning and skills gained in research and evidence-based practice through your academic experience and clinical practice.

- **4.** Three (3) Letters of Recommendation (see pages 3 and 4). Must be received by February 16, 2026.
 - If you are within 2 years of graduation one letter must be from a current or former fieldwork educator and one letter from a faculty member.
 - If you have more than 2 years of experience as an occupational therapist, one letter must be from your current supervisor and one letter from a professional colleague.
 - For ALL applicants, the third letter could be from faculty, colleague, or supervisor who can speak to your professional attributes.
- **5. Optional Additional documents:** Research or publication documents are welcome but not required (please include abstract or written product).

Top candidates will be selected for an interview (in-person as available or video-conference as needed).

The final candidates will be confirmed in early March 2026.
